### 2. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:-**

### 2.1 Age limit as on 13.09.2021

The candidate should have completed 15 years of age and should not have completed 24 years as on 13.09.2021, which is the cutoff d: e for receiving applications. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of SC/5 Γ candidates and 03 years in case of OBC candidates as per extant instructions of Railw y Board and as amended from to time. The candidates who want to avail the benefit of eservation of SC/ST, must produce his/her caste certificate on Govt. of India forma issued by appropriate authority as per Annexure-B. Similarly, the candidates who want to avail the benefit of reservation of OBC, must produce caste certificate and Non-Creamy Layer Certificate issued on or after 01.01.2021 on Govt. of India format by appro riate authority as per Annexure-C.

### Minimum Educational Qualification & Tra 1ing Period: 2.2

The candidates willing to undergo training under the Apprentices' Act, 1961, in this Factory, must have passed 10th class examine ion or its equivalent with minimum 50% (aggregate) marks, from recognized Boards, 13 on the date of issue of Notification and also possess National Trade Certificate (NT ) in the designated trade in which this administration is imparting training, issued by National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT).

The training in the designated trades of Fi er, Machinist Mechanic Motor Vehicle, Turner, Electrician and Electronic Mechanic vill be for a period of one year. Whereas the period of training for COE Group (CNC Programming-cum-Operator), is for a period of six months. Training will be arranged in a cordance with the standards and syllabus prescribed by the Central Apprenticeship Coun il.

### 2.3 Engagement of Act Apprentices :-

- The candidates who have registered their names with the Employment Exchanges falling within the State of Karnataka are only eligible to apply. The registration should be current and valid as on the date o issue of this Notification. If applications are received without registration in Employ nent Exchange within the jurisdiction of State of Karnataka, the same will be re-ected (except those coming under the provision of para (ii) below).
- ii) Wards of Serving Railway employees all ov r the Indian Railways are also eligible to apply to undergo the above Apprenticeshir training in various designated trades in this Factory, subject to fulfilling the educat anal/technical qualifications indicated in the Notification. Serving Railway employe s should ensure that the applications of their wards are sent to this Office through neir respective Controlling Officials, in the prescribed proforma as per Annexure-D Such applications should invariably be forwarded by a Gazetted Officer only uncer whose control the Serving Railway Employee is working. However, registrat on of the names of their wards with Employment Exchanges in their respective jurisdiction of the State Employment Exchanges in which they are residing is no necessary.

#### 2.4 Rate of Stipend :-

During their period of apprenticeship trainin in this Factory, the candidates undergoing training in the trades of Fitter, Machinist, Me hanic (Motor Vehicle), Turner, Electrician, Electronic Mechanic will be paid a stipend of Rs.12,261/- per month, while for CNC Programming-cum-Operator, a stipend of Rs. 0,899/- per month, will be paid and as per extant rules amended from time to time.

#### 3. How to apply :-

- a) Candidates are required to read the i structions indicated in the Notification thoroughly before submitting their applica ions.
- b) Application Format as per Annexure-A ar 1 all other Annexures-B, C, D & E can be downloaded from the official vebsite Rail Wheel www.rwf.indianrailways.gov.in Factory
- c) No other format of applications, other than the one enclosed to this Notification, shall be entertained.
- d) Candidates should note and take cognizan e of the fact that this is a Notification for engagement of Act Apprentices under the Apprentices' Act, 1961, for this Factory and Rail Wheel Factory Administration is the raidal agency for processing of applications from candidates and preparation of their me it list.
- e) Candidates should ensure that their Name, Father's/Mother's name/Guardian's name, their Date of Birth, in the application form submitted by them should exactly match as recorded in their Matriculation or equ valent certificates and other certificates including Aadhaar certificates submitted by them. Any deviation found during document verification will lead to cancell tion of their candidature and also their debarment from undergoing training in this actory.

- f) An Ex-servicemen candidate selected under the reservation provided for him/her will be placed in the appropriate category viz., 1 R/SC/ST/OBC to which he/she belongs. In case of children of Ex-servicemen, the must produce discharge certificate of his/her parents at the time of document verification.
- g) A recent colour pass port size photograph s ould be affixed on the application form duly signed/attested by the candidate.

#### 3.1 Payment of Fees :-

The candidates are required to enclose an India Postal Order/Demand Draft from any Nationalised Bank of Rs.100/- as processing fee drawn in favour of 'Principal Financial Adviser/Rail Wheel Factory,' along with applic tion form, which is not refundable. No fee is required to be paid by SC/ST/Phys cally handicapped/Women candidates. Applications not accompanied with processing f e, wherever required, will be summarily rejected. Candidates may please note that these astruments should not have been issued earlier to the date of issue of this Notification.

- g) Employment Registration card, registered i Employment Exchanges within the State of Karnataka, with renewal being current. (This is applicable in case of candidates residing in State of Karnataka other than wa ds of Serving Railway Employees.)
- h) Wards of serving Railway employees should produce certificate issued by the respective controlling officers where their parents are working in the prescribed proforma Annexure-D.

Note:- Please note that all copies should be self attested and Original Certificates should not be enclosed along with the application form.

## 3.3.1 Important Dates :-

a) The last date for submission of applic tion 13.09.2021

b) Probable date of display of list of sele ted candidates – 45 days from the closing date of receipt of applications.

c) Tentative Date of commencement of Training - 15 days after issue of merit list.

### 4. Mode of selection :-

## 4.1 Mode of consideration :-

The selection of candidates will be made on the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks. For the purpose of calculation of percentage of marks obtained in 10<sup>th</sup> Std/Matriculation or its equivalent or its equivalent marks obtained by the candidates in all the subjects as indicated in not on the basis of marks of any subject or a group of subjects.

## 4.2 Consideration when marks are equal:-

In case of two candidates having the same marks, the candidates with older age shall be preferred. In case of dates of births are also being the same, then the candidate who passed the 10<sup>th</sup> Std/Matriculation or its equival nt examination earlier, shall be considered first.

### 4.3 Allotment of Trade :-

- a) A final merit list would be prepared et all to the number of designated trades proposed to be filled up duly er uring and providing reservation to SC/ST/OBC/PH/Ex-Servicemen candidates, etc., in the descending order of percentage of marks obtained by the canditates as stated above, and as per the terms and conditions indicated in the Notification, for filling up of these slots in various designated trades.
- b) Seats of PWD and Ex-Servicemen as not fied are not separate, but included in the total number of seats as per provision.
- c) An Ex-servicemen candidate selected unde the reservation provided for him/her will be placed in the appropriate category viz., R/SC/ST/OBC to which he/she belongs. Reservations to Ex-servicemen, their child in for engagement as a trainee under the Apprentices Act, 1961 to undergo training in various designated trades in this Factory, will be provided as under:-
  - Children of deceased/disabled Ex-servic men including those killed/disabled during peace time.
  - ii) Children of Ex-servicemen
  - iii) Children of Serving Jawans
  - iv) Children of Serving Officer
  - v) Ex-Servicemen

- d) In case candidates are not available to t e extent required in a particular designated trade(s) indicated above to undergo train 1g, the shortfall of this particular trade, will be made good to the extent required in ot er designated trades, indicated above.
- e) When the prescribed number of persons belonging either to the Scheduled Castes or to the Scheduled Tribes are not availabed; the training places so reserved for them will be filled by persons belonging to the Scheduled Caste respectively, and if the prescribed training places cannot be filled even in the above given manner, the prescribed training places cannot be settled by persons not belonging to the Scheduled Castes or the Scheduled Tribes. Similarly, the seats remaining unfilled by OBC candidates will be filled by unreserved category.
- f) Candidates finally enlisted to undergo training in this Factory would be subjected to verification of original testimonials.

### 4.4 Standard of Physical Fitness :-

- a) A person shall be eligible for being traned under the Apprentices Act, 1961 and Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 as amended from time to time, if he/she satisfies the minimum standards of physical fitness as prescribed in the aforesaid Acts and Rules and the standards prescribed for imparting training in the above designated trades, which will be certified by a government authorized Doctor (Gazetted) not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon of Central/State Hospital.
- b) The selected candidates will have to so mit the prescribed medical examination certificate in the prescribed proforma (Annexure 'E') enclosed before their engagement.

# 4.4.1 Standards of Fitness for the persons with disability for Engagement as Act Apprentice to undergo training – Definition of Disabilities:-

- a) Blindness: "Blindness" refers to a condi on where a person suffers from any of the following conditions, viz.,:
  - i) Total absence of sight; or
  - ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 of 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses; or
  - iii) Limitation of the field for vision subten ling an angle of 20 degree or worse;
- b) Lew Vision (VH): "Person with low vi ion" means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or andard refractive correction but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision or planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.
- c) Hearing impairment: "Hearing impair ent" means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational r nge of frequencies. Hearing impairment would also include persons who are 'deaf & dumb.
- d) Locomotor disability: "Locomotor disal lity means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy.

- e) Cerebral Palsy: "Cerebral Palsy" means ε group of non-progressive conditions of a person characterized by abnormal motor cor rol posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the prenatal, peri-natal r infant period of development.
- f) All the cases of orthopedically handicapp if persons would be covered under the category of "loco motor disability or cerebra palsy".

### 4.5 Higher Qualification :-

Engineering Graduates and Diploma Holders : e not eligible to apply for undergoing Apprenticeship Training in response to this 1 otification, as they are governed by a separate scheme of Apprenticeship.

### 5. Agreement :-

- a) Before commencement of the Apprenticeshi , training in the designated trade in this Factory, the selected candidates, have to ex cute a Contract of Apprenticeship with the Employer. If the candidate is a Minor, hen his/her guardian has to enter into a contract of Apprenticeship with the Employe
- b) If the candidate is selected as Trade Ap rentice in this Factory in the above designated trades, his completion of training will be subject to registration by Regional Directorate of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (RDSDE), Bengaluru. If due to any reason, RDSDE/Bengaluru refuses registration, the training of the candidate will be terminated immediately.
- c) The candidate who has completed the period of training will, on passing a test to be conducted by the National Council for Training (NCVT) in Vocational Trades to determine his designated proficiency in which he/she has served, as an Apprentice, will be given a certificate of proficiency in the trade by the National Council.
- d) The candidates selected to undergo training shall be governed by the provision of Apprentices Act, 1961 and Apprenticeship Ri es, 1992, as amended from time to time and such other Rules and Regulations form d by the Railway Administration from time to time.
- e) Candidates selected to undergo the above training in various designated trades under the Apprentices Act, 1961, will not be allowed to withdraw from the course except for reasons which are beyond their control. In the case of those who willfully absent themselves, their contract of apprenticeship will be terminated and the training cost of an amount equivalent to his/her three months last drawn stipend, shall be recoverable from such candidates or from his her surety, as the case may be and also as per the Rules of the Railway Administration. The decision of the Railway Administration in this regard will be final and binding.

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f) Selected candidates are required to register t e contract of Apprenticeship in an online mode. In view of the above, selected candidates are required to access the Apprenticeship portal and register themselve on this portal.

Candidates, in their own interest, are advited to register themselves on the above portal at the earliest without waiting for the final select list to be published.

### 6. Invalid applications :-

Candidates are required to read instructions care 'ully before submitting the applications. Otherwise, their applications will be rejected or any of the following reasons or on any other valid reasons as decided by this Administra ion:

## Applications of candidates will be treated as it valid for the following reasons :-

- a) Applications without photograph of the candidate, Application received with photograph but not signed/attested by the can idate.
- b) Applications sent in any other form other that the one specified in the Notification.
- c) Applications not accompanied with processin fee, wherever required, as stipulated in Notification.
- d) Candidates with less than 50% marks in 10th 5 d./Matriculation or its equivalent.
- e) Applications not accompanied with proof of elonging to SC/ST and OBC, wherever required in the prescribed proforma, and also if the sub-caste is not appearing in the Central Gazette Notification, of respective Sta es.
- f) Applications received with other than the prescribed Educational/Technical (ITI) qualifications in various designated trades as i dicated in the Notification.
- g) Applicants not registered with local Employm nt Exchanges in various districts in the State of Karnataka (in case of candidates resid ag in Karnataka).
- h) Applications of the candidates received after the closing date i.e, 13.09.2021
- Applications received without candidate's si nature in application form, wherever required.
- Applications not filled and signed by the candidates in the checklist Annexure-E enclosed to the Notification.
- k) Applications with the certificate (to be sub nitted by wards of Serving Railway Employees) which are not attested by Gaze ed Officers under whom the Serving Railway Servant is working, which is pre-n quisite condition, as indicated in the prescribed proforma.
- Applications with the IPOs/DDs which hav been procured before issue of this Notification.
- m) Applications where there is a variation in the a nount and words in the Demand Drafts submitted by the candidates as processing fee, nclosed to the applications.

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- n) Candidates who have only submitted marks card and have not enclosed the National Trade Certificate issued by National Counci for Vocational Training (NCVT).
- o) Please note that the certificate issued by CVT will not be entertained and such applications will be treated as invalid.
- p) Candidates of other States who are not ware of Serving Railway Employees, even if they fulfill the age/Educational qualification. [echnical qualification (ITI).
- q) Candidates who are already undergoing/cc npleted the Apprenticeship Training in other Organisation.
- r) Candidates who are over aged or under aged or whose Date of Birth is not filled or is wrongly filled.
- s) If the left hand thumb impression is not aff xed/blurred/smudged on the application form.
- f) Application received without colour phote or photo with cap, wearing goggles, disfigured, unrecognizable or scanned/Xerox :opy.
- u) Incomplete and Ineligible application.
- v) If more than one application is submitted by he same candidate all such applications will be treated as invalid.

will have no claim to seek employment on tailways on the basis of such training.
