

Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus 2023: The Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus 2023 includes four main components that candidates need to prepare for in order to successfully qualify for the job. The first component is the Pre-Exam Paper, which is an objective (MCQ) type test that is conducted offline in both English and Odia languages. This exam consists of 150 questions, with each correct answer carrying one mark and a negative marking of 0.5 marks for every incorrect answer. The exam is divided into four sections, including General Knowledge, General English, Logical Reasoning, and Quantitative Aptitude.

The second component is the Mains Exam, which is divided into three papers, each carrying 100 marks and having a duration of 3 hours. The total mark for the Mains-Exam is 300, and the papers include General Awareness, English, and Mathematics. The exam is objective type and is conducted offline in both English and Odia languages.

The third component is the Computer Application Test, which is conducted for 100 marks and has a duration of 1 hour. The test comprises theoretical and skill-based questions covering topics like Computer Fundamentals, Windows, MS Office, Linux fundamentals, Open Office Applications, Usage of Internet Operation, Communication Technology, Networking Concepts, and Digital Signature.

The final component of the Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus 2023 is the Document Verification stage, where candidates who have qualified in the earlier rounds are called for verification of their documents. It is essential that candidates carry all the necessary documents and certificates for verification. With thorough preparation for all four components, candidates can increase their chances of success in the recruitment process.

Odisha High Court ASO Pre-Paper Syllabus 2023

Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus 2023: The Odisha High Court has recently announced the syllabus for the Assistant Section Officer (ASO) exam that is scheduled to be held in 2023. This exam will be conducted offline and will be of graduate level. The ASO exam will be objective type with multiple-choice questions (MCQs), and will be conducted in both English and Odia languages. The total number of questions in the exam will be 150, and the maximum marks that a candidate can score are also 150. For every correct answer, one mark will be awarded, however, there will be negative marking for wrong answers, with 0.5 marks being deducted for each incorrect response.

The ASO exam will comprise of Paper 1, which will test the candidate's knowledge in General Knowledge, General English, Logical Reasoning, and Quantitative Aptitude. Candidates who are preparing for this exam should ensure that they are well-versed in all these areas in order to score well and secure their desired position in the Odisha High Court.

6. SYLLABUS OF EXAMINATION:

The Recruitment Examination shall consist of Preliminary Examination/Test, Main Written Examination, Computer Application Test and Viva-Voce Test as detailed below.

(A) Preliminary Examination/Test - 150 marks (2 hours duration)

The Preliminary Examination/Test shall carry 150 marks in accordance with the Graduation Course on the subjects of General English, General Knowledge, Logical Reasoning and Quantitative Aptitude. In such Preliminary Test there shall be 150 numbers of Objective Type of Questions with Multiple Choice Answers.

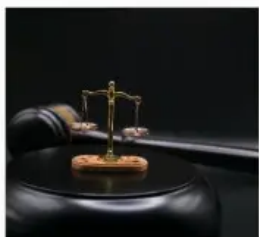

Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus 2023: The Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus for the year 2023 has been released. The exam will be conducted by the High Court of Orissa, but the exact date of the exam is yet to be announced. The exam will be conducted in offline mode and will be of graduate level. The exam will be an objective type exam, and the papers will be available in both English and Odia language. There will be a total of three papers in the exam, and each paper will carry 100 marks. The total marks of the exam will be 300.

The first paper will be on General Awareness, the second paper will be on English, and the third paper will be on Mathematics. Each paper will carry 100 marks, and the questions will be objective in nature. Candidates who are interested in the exam should start preparing according to the syllabus provided by the High Court.

- Current Affairs: Latest happenings in India and around the world in various fields such as politics, sports, science, technology, etc.
- National & International Events: Important national and international events and their significance.
- Major Financial/Economic news: Budget, Five-year plans, and other economic news.
- Books & Authors: Famous books and their authors.
- Awards & Honours: National and International awards and their recipients.
- Abbreviations: Important abbreviations used in various fields.
- Important Days: National and International days and their significance.

- International & National Organization: Important international and national organizations and their functions.
- History: Major events in Indian and World History.
- Geography: Important geographical features and their significance.
- Politics: Indian and World politics and their significance.
- Civics: The constitution of India, fundamental rights, and duties.
- Culture: Indian and World culture and their significance.

Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus Mains Paper 2 English 100 marks

- Essay writing: Candidates will be asked to write a 500-word essay on a given topic to test their ability to express their thoughts coherently and logically.
- Precis writing: Candidates will be asked to write a summary of a given passage in about 200 words to test their ability to understand the essence of a text and express it concisely.
- Translation: Candidates will be asked to translate a paragraph from English to their chosen language to test their language proficiency.
- Re-translation: Candidates will be asked to translate a paragraph from their chosen language to English to test their language proficiency.
- Grammar: Candidates will be tested on their knowledge of grammar rules, including parts of speech, tenses, voice, and subject-verb agreement.

Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus Mains Paper 3 Mathematics 100 marks

- Arithmetic: Number system, Percentage, Ratio and Proportion, Profit and Loss, Simple and Compound Interest, Time and Work, Time and Distance.
- Algebra: Algebraic Identities, Linear Equations in one variable and their applications, Quadratic Equations and their applications, Polynomials and their operations.
- Mensuration: Area and perimeter of plane figures such as circles, squares, rectangles, and triangles, Volume and Surface area of solid figures such as cubes, cylinders, spheres, and cones.
- Statistics & Probability: Measures of central tendency, measures of dispersion, correlation and regression, probability, random variable, and its probability distribution.

(C) Computer Application Test: 100 marks (1 hour duration)

[Computer Fundamentals, Windows (MS- Windows), MS Office (Word, Excel & Power Point), Linux Fundamental and Open Office Application, Usage of Internet Operation, Communication Technology, Networking Concepts (LAN, Ethernet, Broad Band, Wireless) and Digital Signature]

The Court shall call the candidates for Computer Test, who have secured not less than 45% of marks in aggregate and a minimum of 33% of marks in each paper in the Main Written Examination. Such marks in case of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates shall be 40% and 30% respectively.

Provided further that, Computer Test shall be qualifying in nature, and the qualifying mark shall be 50% of the total marks in the said paper. Such mark obtained in Computer Test shall not be taken into account while drawing up the Final Merit List.

Odisha High Court ASO Syllabus 2023: The Computer Application Test is an important component of many recruitment exams and is designed to assess a candidate's knowledge and skills in various computer applications. The test comprises 100 marks and has a duration of one hour. The test is divided into two sections - theory and skill tests. The theory section carries 50 marks and has a duration of half an hour, while the skill test also carries 50 marks and has a duration of half an hour.

The topics covered in the test include Computer Fundamentals, Windows (MS-Windows), MS Office (Word, Excel & PowerPoint), Linux Fundamental and Open Office Application, Usage of Internet Operation, Communication Technology, Networking Concepts (LAN, Ethernet, Broad Band, Wireless), and Digital Signature. Candidates must have a good understanding of these topics to perform well in the test. The table below summarizes the format of the Computer Application Test:
