Pursuant to the New HR methodology for induction of Agrilveervisyu under 'Agrilpath Scheme', aimed to provide an opportunity to Nation's youth to experience military way of life for a period of four years, Indian Air Force invites ONLINE application from unmarried Indian male and female candidates for selection test from 13 October 2023 onwards to Join the IAF as an AGNIVEERVAYD. The number and employability of female candidates will be decided as per service requirement.

(THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/ PILOTS/ NAVIGATORS)

- Application is required to be filled only ONLINE by the candidates and detailed instructions to fill up the same are available at https://janjaathwayu.cdec.in.
- This examination is valid for AGNIVEERVAYU INTAKE 01/2024.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION shall commence at 1900h on 27 July 2023 and will close at 2300h on 17 August 2023, Only ONLINE REGISTERED applications shall be accepted. For registration log on to https://iagnipathyayu.cdac.in

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

5. Age.

- (a) Date of Birth Block. Candidate born between 27 June 2003 and 27 December 2006 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.
- In case, a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure, then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be
- 6. Marital Status and Pregnancy. Only unmarried candidates (male & female) will be eligible for enrolment as Agriveervayu and they shall undertake not to many during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agriveervayu inclusive of training, skill development activities, practical as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continued service of Agriveervayu during the engagement period, longer absence of Agriveervayu during the engagement period, longer absence of Agriveervayu during the suit period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agriveervayu will be eligible for selection in regular carder as Airman. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such women Agriveervayu on becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be tailed to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will death the vomen Agriveervayu for selection into Regular Cadre. All the time of enrolment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions.

Educational Qualification

Candidates should have passed Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Educ Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from Central State and UT recognized Polyscrinic Institute with 50% mains in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Diploma Course (or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course).

Passed Two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subject viz. Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognize by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

(b) Other than Science Subjects

Passed Informediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 59% marks in aggregate and 59% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

Mandatory Medical Standards. General Medical Standards for AGNIVEERVAYU male & female candidates are as follows:-

- (i) For Male candidates: Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cms.
- For Female candidates: Minimum acceptable height is 152 cms. For candidates belonging to North East or hilly regions of khand, a lower minimum height of 147 cms will be accepted. In case of candidates from Lakshadweep, the minimum height will be

- (g) Corneal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable.
 - Note: Candidates should bring prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The latest prescription should contain diopter measurement, Optitualmologist's registration number, stamp, signature and date of prescription should be within a month prior to appearing for medical examination.
- n) General Health: Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages, He / She should be free from any active or entroic, medical or surgical disability or communicable disease, infection and skin aliments. Candidate shall be physically and entitly FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain.
- naecological Examination (For female candidates): The examination covers external genitalia, hernia orifices and the perineum, any f stress urinary incontinence or genital prolapse outside introllus.

- (k) Gender (For female candidates): Any candidate if found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as evident on external physical examination, will be rejected as Unifit. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared Unifi.
- Pregnancy (For female candidates): Any candidate, if found to be pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature

- Body Tattoo. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 12. Agriveervayu will be enrolled in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950, for a period of FOUR years. Agriveervayu would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agriveervayu beyond the ingagement period of four years.
- On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, secretary usell be offered an opportunity to apply for serviment in the regular cadre of the Indian Air Force as Airmen. These applications will be stered in a centralised minumer based on objective orbans, including performance during their four-year engagement period and up to 25% of specific batch of Agrivereneys will be enrolled in regular cadre of IAF. Agrivereneys will not have any right to be selected for further ment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agrilveeneysy for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the

- 23. <u>Online Test</u>. Eligible candidates will be sent provisional admit cards for Phase I of testing on their registered e-mail IDs between 48-72 km prior to the examination. Candidates are required to download the admit card, take a colour printout and carry the same to the examination centre. Name of city & exam date will be intimated to candidates at an earlier date to enable them to plan their movement. Candidates declared medically unit can avail the option for 'Appeal Medical Board' (AMB) against their unifitness by depositing Rs. 40/i a Government Treasury/RBVSSI strough Electronic Military Receivable Order (e-I/RO) / Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for Al along with original copy of e-I/RO / MRO, photocopy of Unifiness Cardificate are to be submitted to the representative of ASC within three works days of medical examination.

- The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armad Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit list medical estimation, appeal medical board and medical examination prior to environent.
