

The applicants can print their hall ticket for the Computer Based Test (CBT) online from the Medical University website www.kgmu.org.


Computer Based Test (CBT) for all candidates

A Computer Based Test (CBT) will be held. CBT will be of **02.00 hours duration** and will be of **100 marks**. It will contain multiple choice questions (MCQs) 60 marks on the subject(s) related to the post and of the level of the qualifications required 10 marks on General English 10 marks on General Knowledge 10 marks on Reasoning10 marks on Mathematical Aptitude. Simultaneously, **01(one)** mark will be given for the correct answer and 1/3 (one-third) mark will be deducted for the wrong answer (i.e. there will be negative marking)
