- a. Syllabus for Tamil language eligibility examination is of class 10th standard level.
- b. Minimum 40% marks in part A examination (minimum qualifying marks) only to be eligible for the next level of evaluation of the main examination answer sheet.
- c. The procedure will be followed as mentioned in the G.O.(Ms) No. 49, Human Resources (M) Department, dated 23.05.2022 for exempting the differently abled candidates from the Compulsory Tamil Language eligibility test.
