

Numerical Aptitude for Competitive Exams

- 3. Relationship between numbers: In this section, you will be tested on your understanding of the relationship between numbers. This includes topics like factors, multiples, and prime numbers.
- 4. Fundamental arithmetical operations: This section will test your proficiency in basic arithmetic operations like addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- 5. Percentages: Questions in this section will test your ability to calculate percentages of a given quantity, increase or decrease of a quantity by a certain percentage, and percentage change.
- 6. Ratio and proportion: This section will test your understanding of ratios and proportions, and their applications in real-world scenarios.
- 7. Average: This section will test your ability to calculate the average of a given set of numbers.
- 8. Interest: Questions in this section will test your understanding of simple and compound interest, and their applications.
- 9. Profit and loss: This section will test your ability to calculate profit or loss percentage, cost price, selling price, and other related concepts.
- 10. Discount: Questions in this section will test your understanding of discounts and their applications.
- 11. Time and distance: This section will test your ability to solve problems related to distance, speed, and time.
- 12. Ratio and time: Questions in this section will test your understanding of the relationship between ratios and time, and their applications.
- 13. Time and work: This section will test your ability to solve problems related to work done by a person or machine in a given time.

18. MODE OF SELECTION


- (a) <u>SCREENING OF APPLICATIONS</u>. Indian Navy will screen all applications registered online, as per eligibility criteria and terms and conditions specific by Government of India from time to time. Merely fulfilling the basic selection criteria does not automatically entitle a person/applicant to be called for the online test.
- (b) <u>SCHEME OF EXAMINATION</u>. All shortlisted/eligible candidates will have to appear in the computer based examination consisting of **100 objective questions** based on syllabus as appended below:-

19. INDICATIVE SYLLABUS FOR EXAMINATION:

- (a) <u>GENERAL INTELLIGENCE AND REASONING</u>. It would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal type. The test will include questions of analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discriminating observation relation concepts, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series etc. The test will also include question design to test the candidate abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.
- (b) <u>GENERAL AWARENESS</u>. It would include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to current events of nation and international importance, sports, history, culture, geography, economics, general policy including Indian constitution and general science etc. These questions will be such that they do not require special study of any discipline.
- (c) ENGLISH LANGUAGE. In addition to the testing of candidates understanding of English language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structur synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage etc. His/her writing ability would also be tested.
- (d) NUMERICAL APTITUDE. This paper will include question on problems relating to number systems, computations of whole number, decimal ar fraction and relationship between numbers, fundamental arithmetical operations, percentages, ration and proportion, average, interest, profit and los discount, time and distance, ration and time, time and work etc.
- (e) KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRADE. The test will include questions relating to trade/posts as per the essential / desirable qualification required and job description specified.

Note. The question paper will be bilingually in English and Hindi languages only, except for the question paper for General English, which will be in English language only. There will be no negative marking for wrong answer.
