

The SSC CHSL Tier-1 exam is conducted by the Staff Selection Commission for recruitment to various government posts. It is an online (CBT) objective type (MCQ) exam, available in Hindi and English, except for the language subject. The exam consists of four sections: General Intelligence & Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, English Language, and General Awareness. It has 100 questions worth 2 marks each, and candidates are given 60 minutes to complete it (80 minutes for PWD candidates). The exam is of an intermediate level and requires a 12th-grade education. Candidates should refer to the official SSC CHSL Syllabus 2023 Tier-1 for detailed topic-wise coverage of each subject.


