

Notification No- 01/2018/JHS

Engagement of Act Apprentice under Apprentice Act 1961 for the year 2018-19

As per instructions given in Railway Board's letter No. E(MPP)/2009/06/14 dated 06.10.2015 it is proposed to make a panel of candidates for act apprentice training under Apprentice act, 1961 for total 446 seats in Jhansi Division as per following details:

Note- Training period (As per Apprentice Act, 1961): One Year.

1. Reservation is as per Rly Bd's L. No.- E(MPP)2002/6/10 Dtd. 17.06.2011. The reserved places are SC 15%, ST 7.5% OBC 27% in which 4.5% minorities are included. If the prescribed number of person belonging either to the Scheduled castes are not available, then the seats so reserved for them may be filled by persons belonging to the Scheduled Tribes and vice-versa as the cases may be

the seats so lying unfilled may be filled by persons not belonging to the Scheduled castes of Scheduled Tribes, Similarly the seats remaining unfilled by OBC candidates be filled by unreserved category.

1.1 03% of total seats are reserved for Ex. Serviceman, their children and children of armed Force Personnel, as pe details mentioned below-

- a) Children of decease/disabled Ex-Serviceman including those killed/disabled during peace time.
- b) Children of Ex-Serviceman.
- c) Children of serving jawans.
- d) Children of serving officers.
- e) Ex-serviceman.

1.2 03% of total seats will be reserved for physically handicapped candidates. Only OH and HH candidates of Fitter, Mechanic (DSL) and Electrician trade having less than 40% or more of relevant disability or those having hearing disability of 60 decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequency are eligible to apply. A physical handicapped person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation would have to submit a disability certificate issued by a competent authority i.e. Medical Board constituted by the Central or State Government.

1.3 All candidates have to acquire a registration no. after registering online at www.apprenticeship.gov.in. Registered candidates must ensure that they apply in the same portal for vacancies at DRM Office Jhansi and upload the necessary documents as mentioned in the website. Registration no. from the said website must be sent to this office along with the application otherwise the candidature may be terminated. Details of procedure to register on the website www.apprenticeship.gov.in is mentioned in the FAQ and Help sections on top right corner of the portal.

2. **Training Period and Training Place-** Training period will be of one year as prescribed by Railway Board's letter dated 31.05.2017 (RBE No. 54/2017) Training place will be Diesel Shed Jhansi, A.C. Loco Shed Jhansi & Carriage Wagon Department Jhansi.

ELIGIBILITY

3. Age limit

- a) Candidate must have completed 15 years and should not have completed 24 years of age as on **17.12.2018**.
- b) The upper age limit may be relaxed by 5 years in case of SC/ST candidates and 3 years in case of OBC candidates.
- c) For physically handicapped persons upper age limit is relaxed by 10 years.

4. **Educational qualification** The candidate must have passed 10th class examination or its equivalent (under 10+2 system) with minimum 50% marks and possess essential ITI passed certificate in related trade from a recognized Industrial Training Institute affiliated to NCVT/SCVT. Certificate issued by principal is not accepted.

5. **Stipend** Stipend will be paid as per instructions issued by Railway Board from time to time.

6. **Fee** An India Postal Order of Rs. 100/- in favour of Sr. DFM Jhansi and payable at Jhansi as an application fee may be sent as an enclosure with the application. The SC, ST, Physically handicapped and Women candidates are relaxed from application fee.

7. **Mode of Application** The application and call letter must be filled by candidate in his/her own hand writing in the given format on A4 sheet by ballpoint pen and sent to the following address by ordinary/registered post only:

11. Selection process-

- i) The selection of Act Apprentice for training will be done on the basis of merit list prepared from the candidates who have applied & eligible in reference to the notification. There will be no written exam or interview/or exam in this selection.
- ii) Merit list will be prepared on the basis of percentage of total mark obtained in 10th or equivalent examination as well as average marks obtained in ITI by a candidate from recognized educational board/institute
- iii) The calculation of percentage of marks will be based on the total marks obtained in 10th or its equivalent examination from an educational Board/ Institute and not the basis of mark of any subject or a group of subject.
- iv) If more than one candidate gets equal marks/percentage in 10th examination and average mark in ITI or its equivalent examination, than the elder candidates whose date of birth is earlier will be higher in rank than the other whose date of birth comes later. The above information will be computerized and merit will be prepared like this.
- v) Select list will be prepared Trade/Community/Category (Reservation Category) wise out of final select list of combined merit.
- vi) The candidate equal to 1.5 times of the number of slots for Act Apprentices shall be called for verification of original testimonials and their physical fitness A final merits list of relevant trade will be prepared equal to the no. of slots in the descending order of average percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in matriculation. (Matriculation of 10 class in 10+2 examination system and ITI).
- vii) The candidates will be declared fit for training after being given the medical fitness certificate on successful medical examination by authorized Railway Medical Officer. If the candidates fail in medical examination, his/her candidature will be cancelled and his/her any claim for training will not be accepted.
- viii) No Daily allowance or Travelling allowance will be admissible to candidates

ix) Foster/Residential facility will not be provided to selected candidates and as per apprentice act 1961 the select candidates have to arrange themselves boarding and lodging arrangements during course of training period.

11.1 The merit list of selected candidates will be uploaded on the website www.ncr.indianrailways.gov.in of North Central Railway & candidates included in eligible list will be informed by post. No correspondence will made in this regard to other candidates.

11.2 It is made clear that indian railways will not have any binding to give employment to apprentices. As per para 10 of Schedule 5(II) of apprenticeship rules-1992 (notified on 15.07.92 Government will not be responsible to give employment to trained act apprentices. (Authority-Railway Board L. No. E(MPP)/2009/6/14 dt. 06.10.2015)

11.3 The candidates who have already completed their training under apprentice act, 1961 from any institute/establishment or not eligible to apply under this notification.

12. **Agreement of Training** The selected candidate or his/her guardian (in case of minor) has to execute an apprenticeship contract or agreement with employer before apprenticeship training as prescribed under the Apprenticeship Act 1961.

13. After completion of training period apprentice agreement will be lapsed. After completion of training every apprentice have to go for trade test on all India level conducted by Director General Training, Ministry of Skill Development And Entrepreneurship.

14. The decision of administration regarding selection of candidates and their training will be final. If letter on at any stage it is found that selected candidate has given wrong/false information regarding his/her integrity than the candidate will be dismissed at once without any further notice.
